Pukekohe High School has a proud history of participation and achievement in sport at local, regional, and national levels. We believe it is an integral part of every young person's education journey. Our vision, "learning without limits through sport" and our philosophy, "better people make better athletes" are at the core of the experience we provide to all our student Athletes. We aim to provide meaningful sporting experiences that creates a lifelong love for sport and physical activity, this could be through participating or competing socially to high performing sport.

We encourage students to participate in a wide range of activities outside the classroom to further develop physical, mental, and social skills. We sent 23 teams away to National/regional tournaments across summer (10) and winter tournament week (13) to proudly represent Pukekohe High School. We are constantly aiming to grow and build a strong sports programme that harnesses and allows our talented Rangatahi to compete and display their talents on a national or international stage.

We have an extremely passionate and enthusiastic Sports Department, school staff, Senior Leadership Team and Board of Trusties that support our programme. With the support from our wider community of coaches, managers and parents we put in the hard mahi in to ensure students achieve their sporting goals.


